Morten Brask (b. 1970) grew up in Copenhagen. His family history counts painters and writers, lawyers, politicians and psychologists: Legendary author Karen Blixen, a Russian colonel in the zar's army, a successful gold digger in Siberia, a mayor of Copenhagen and chairman of

the Danish parliament, a director of The Danish National Bank and a member Amundsens expedition through the Northwest passage in 1906.

Early writings

Morten Brask began writing at an early age. At the age of 15 he wrote his first novel, The Snail Farm, won a short story competition and published his first contributions in Danish newspapers. During his university years he contributed to Danish and Norwegian newspapers, magazines and periodicals. Mainly



articles, features and short stories. His first nonfiction-book was published in 1995.

Morten Brask has published eleven books, both non-fiction, biographies, satirical pamphlets, literary travel books and 4 novels.
